The purpose of the Dress Code is to develop self-responsibility and respect, to promote habits of neatness, good grooming, and hygiene, and to provide a serious learning environment. It is the responsibility of *each parent* to make sure students follow the dress code every day.

St. Anne will use Tommy Hilfiger Uniforms, French Toast, and Lands' End as our primary uniform suppliers. Official uniform gear may be purchased from these suppliers; however, khaki bottoms (i.e., shorts, skirts, and/or pants) may be purchased from any retailer if they fall under the guidelines found within the following pages.

All students must follow the guidelines below

- Shirts are to always remain tucked in.
- Belts are to be worn by both boys and girls anytime khaki pants or shorts are worn.
- No shorts/skirts may be shorter than 3" above the knee.
- Socks and Tights should be solid and opaque White or Navy in color.
- The Mass Uniform is to be worn on required days.
- No Hooded items shall be worn during Mass.
- No coats or jackets other than specified uniform items shall be worn in the classroom.

The following items are *not* permitted while in uniform, for Spirit Days, or on Uniform Free Days

- Open-toed shoes
- Crocs
- Clogs
- High heels
- Scarves
- Bandannas
- Cargo style shorts or pants
- Layered long sleeve shirts under the required polo or button-down shirt
- A shirt or sweatshirt bearing a student's name or monogram that is visible to the public
- Sleeveless Tops
- Any top showing midriff area
- Inappropriate logos and/or political statements
- Low cut necks showing cleavage
- Torn clothing
- Low rise pants
- Sagging pants (worn below waistline)
- Visible undergarments of any type
- Leggings in lieu of pants
- Hats (unless included in a specific theme)
- Multiple piercings
- Body piercings

- Visible tattoos or body art
- Writing or drawings on body
- Body spray (boy or girl), perfumed lotions, perfumes, colognes, etc.

PRESCHOOL STUDENTS

Preschool students will follow the K-5 guidelines for both genders, but polos will not require a crest and there are no Mass uniform requirements. PE, Spirt Days, and Uniform Free Day policies also apply to preschool students.

FIELD TRIPS

Students and Families will receive guidance from their teachers regarding appropriate attire for the field trip.

SHORTS and SWEATER VEST

Shorts may be worn from the opening school day until November 1st and again from April 1st until the close of the school year for Pre-K through 5th grade. Middle school has no restrictions on shorts. PE shorts are acceptable year-round.

Our Mass Day sweater vest will be required from October 1st thru April 30th. It will be optional during the hotter months (August 1st thru September 30th and May 1st thru the end of the school year). All other Mass Day items are required, regardless of whether one chooses to wear the sweater vest.

ALTERNATIVE RETAILERS

Uniform items may be purchased from alternative retailers. If purchasing from an alternative retailer, it will be the parent's responsibility to make sure the items purchased follow the dress code fully.

PERSONAL GROOMING

Hair:

- Students should have naturally colored hair
- Neatly cut and groomed, and for boys, no longer than the collar of their shirt

Make-up:

- No makeup for girls in K-5
- Middle School girls should have modest makeup

LOST AND FOUND

Parents should label students' coats, hats, sweaters, lunch boxes, uniform items, and other personal items. Please check the lost and found bins if something goes missing. The school is not responsible for lost items.

UNIFORM DONATION RACKS

St. Anne offers gently worn uniforms to other families for their use and benefit. The racks are in the school and sorted by size. Parents are welcome to come into school and drop off or take items they need. **Parents are responsible for making sure any items taken adhere to the dress code.**
